For this year's raffle bike, the museum was able to do something a little different. We all know how generous people in the motorcycle industry are, and when J&P Cycles offered to step up and do a custom build for the museum, manufacturers around the industry jumped at the chance to donate parts. Underground Studios and fabricator Aaron Frank of Cedar Rapids, IA also came on board and offered to do the paint and fabrication free of charge.

Designed by J&P Cycles® bike builder Jeff Wiley, this cool, retro Custom Bobber definitely has a nostalgic appeal! It features a Panhead style motor, solo seat and '40's style fender treatment. Similar to the old Indians and Harley '45's, and staying with the historical scheme for the build, the tank was cut and an oil tank was welded in on the back of the right side gas tank. The pipes also wrap around the primary to have a dual exhaust look with the Trumpet mufflers coming out each side. The finished bike is, in one word... HOT!

"We are extremely pleased with this year's bike," said John Parham, President of the Museum's Board of Directors. "The support of the motorcycle industry in this project has been fantastic and the finished bike is absolutely beautiful! The bike will also be featured this season on the Speed Channel program Corbin's Ride-On®. The bike is going to get a lot of great exposure and will hopefully raise a lot of funds for the Museum."
