ANAMOSA, Iowa – Sidecar enthusiasts, mark Saturday, Sept. 11 on your calendar! That is the date of the 7th Annual East Central Iowa Sidecar Rally and it is being held at the NEW National Motorcycle Museum, located at 102 Chamber Drive, Anamosa, from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.

See hundreds of sidecars at this event, sponsored by Sidecars Unlimited and the National Motorcycle Museum, in addition to riders and spectators from across the Midwest. Have breakfast courtesy of the Anamosa AmVets at 107 North Division Street from 6:30 to 9:30 a.m.

The FREE rally features a sidecar show and there will be a ride to Stone City then back through Fairview and through the Wapsipinicon Park. As an all-day event, it might be a good idea to bring some lawn chairs. Get an up close and personal look at the new Museum. Discounted admission of \$7 per person will be offered throughout the day (children 12 and under are free when accompanied by a paying adult).
